ORDINANCE NO. 49

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 5, BEING AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE USE AND SERVICE OF THE WATERWORKS SYSTEM OF THE LAKESIDE WATER DISTRICT, JACKSON AND WILLIAMSON COUNTIES, ILLINOIS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE LAKESIDE WATER DISTRICT, JACKSON AND WILLIAMSON COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Section 9 of Ordinance No. 5 be amended to read as follows:

No owner or plumper shall be permitted to conduct water pipes into any two district premises or tenements, unless separate and distinct stopcocks and meters shall be placed on the outside of each such premise along the road right-of-way opposite the same, nor shall any pipe be allowed to cross lots of buildings to adjoining premises. All Structures containing more that one occupancy unit shall have separate and distinct metering to each unit. The metering must be located on the premises in such a way as to allow division of the unit if such unit is capable of being subdivided.

Section 2: That except as hereby modified and changed, Ordinance No. 5, shall remain the same and in full force and effect.

Section 3: That the charges herein established shall be effective as of September 12, 2006.
