ORDINANCE NUMBER 6.

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING RATES AND CHARGES FOR WATER FURNISHED TO CUSTOMERS OR WATER USERS, OR TO ANY OTHER RESIDENT OF THE LAKESIDE WATER DISTRICT FOR WATER USED FOR THE FIGHTING OF FIRES UPON THEIR PREMISES.

WHEREAS, the Lakeside Water District is not a Fire Prevention District authorized to levy taxes to defray the cost of fighting and prevention of fires within the District, and

WHEREAS, the Lakeside Water District does not have the necessary funds to pay for the water used in the fighting of fires within the District.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE LAKESIDE WATER DISTRICT, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That there shall be a charge of \$25.00 per hour, or part of an hour, for water furnished by the District to customers, or water users, or to any other resident of the Lakeside Water District for the fighting of fires upon their premises. At no time shall said charge be less than a \$25.00 minimum.

SECTION 2. The charge for water furnished for fire fighting as provided in Section 1 above shall be billed to the user the same as other water billing, and the failure or refusal of said user to pay said billing within 10 days from the date of rendering statement therefor shall be grounds for discontinuance of water service to said user.
