ORDINANCE NUMBER 71

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Lakeside Water District has adopted Ordinance Number 5, wherein certain rules and regulations for the use and service of the waterworks system of the District are enumerated, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees amended Ordinance Number 5 as shown in Ordinance Number 68, Section 2, wherein the District clarified its obligation to provide sufficient water pressure and volume for fire protection purposes of any nature, and

WHEREAS, an issue as to maintenance of fire protection lines has arisen and the Board has determined it is necessary to clarify its obligation to provide maintenance of fire protection lines.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE LAKESIDE WATER DISTRICT, JACKSON AND WILLIAMSON COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. <u>CUSTOMERS WITH FIRE PROTECTION LINES</u> Lakeside Water District does not provide Fire Protection at any location within the District or any area where Lakeside Water District watermains exist.

Lakeside Water District shall not maintain unmetered or metered fire protection watermains. Lakeside Water District maintenance and liability shall terminate immediately after the valve which feeds the fire protection branch off of the watermain feeding the fire protection line.

Under no circumstances shall Lakeside Water District maintain any customer fire protection system lines, plumbing or equipment regardless of the location.

At locations where the customer water meter is feed off the fire protection line, Lakeside Water District shall only maintain the meter pit, meter pit ring & lid, water meter, copper setter and miscellaneous equipment housed within the interior of the meter pit. Under no circumstances shall Lakeside Water District maintain service lines or watermains between the fire protection structure or fire protection watermain and the customer's water meter.

SECTION 2. <u>ALL OTHER CUSTOMERS</u> At all other Lakeside Water District customer locations, Lakeside Water District shall maintain the service saddle, corporation stop, service line between the water main and meter pit, meter pit, meter pit ring & lid, water meter, copper setter and miscellaneous equipment housed within the interior of the meter pit. Lakeside Water District maintenance and liability shall terminate immediately after the copper setter on the customer side of the service connection.
